





During 2023 at our camps, we impacted 5,000 lives for God’s glory through discipleship and adventure – the most ever. At our conference center, we impacted 61,000 lives for His glory through purposeful hospitality – 6,000 more than in 2022. In total, that’s enough people to fill every seat at the 2024 Super Bowl, *and* sell concessions, *and* check tickets at the entrance gates, *and* play *and* officiate the actual game. 
ImpAct Campaign Update

Only three years ago, The Ridgecrest Foundation accepted stewardship of Ridgecrest. In doing so, we took a BIG step of faith and incurred a BIG load of debt - almost \$16M.
